



## 2022-23 Family Income Survey

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Schools receive certain federal and state funds (Learning Assistance Program, E-Rate funding for technology, special grants, etc.) based on the number of children from households that are at or below the federal poverty level. The income level of our students was previously determined through Free/Reduced Price Meal Applications that were collected from families. Now that the District is eligible for the **Community Eligibility Provision (CEP)** which allows us to serve meals **at no cost** to all students *regardless of income*, we no longer will collect the old Free/Reduced Meal Apps.

**Instead**, we are asking households to submit this **Family Income Survey** so we can provide to the state the income data for all Entiat students. This information makes sure the Entiat School District continues to receive the full amount of federal and state funding it has been getting, and makes sure your child receives services they are entitled to.

Please submit only one **Family Income Survey** per family.
