### Extracurriculars Are Key To Student Success

Students who participate in extracurricular activities are less likely to skip class or miss school. They are more likely to have a GPA of 3.0 or higher and score well on math and reading assessments. Extracurricular activities have other benefits too:

- **Activities teach universal lessons.** Students learn the value of practice, how to apply themselves to a task, and the satisfaction that comes from achievement. Students involved in multiple activities learn how to manage and plan their time, a key skill for success.
- **Activities build confidence.** Students who struggle in the classroom may begin to doubt their own abilities and skills. Success in an outside activity can create a sense of confidence that translates into more confident classroom performance. It helps struggling students earn esteem among their peers.
- **Activities build relationships.** Sports, theater, music, and other achievement-focused activities increase opportunities for strong adult relationships, mentoring, and positive peer associations.
- **Activities keep students in a safe, monitored place.** By extending the school day, activities can help keep kids out of trouble and help to reduce working parents' anxiety about their children.
- **Activities build character.** Participation helps students develop discipline, commitment, and drive.

### Did You Know?

Extracurriculars also play a part when students apply to colleges. Most college applications ask about activities. That's because what people do with their free time reveals a lot about them - in ways that grades and test scores can't.

## Myth Buster

**MYTH:** Children don't need their parents as much in middle school.

**REALITY:** Some parents think they don't need to be as involved because their kids know all about the school routine by middle school. But the evidence says otherwise. Even at the middle level, parents still play an important role.

Research from Harvard University's Family Research Project shows that the children of involved parents tend to do better in school across a number of measures, including GPA, test scores, and likelihood of enrolling in college.

Engaged parents can also reduce the effects of negative peer pressure that often push kids to become unmotivated in school.

- ☐ **Remind your teen that school still comes first.** Extracurricular activities are important – but doing well in classes trumps sports or clubs. Make sure your child understands your expectations for good grades.

# PRESCHOOL & KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION!!

On **Monday, April 11**, the elementary school office will begin accepting registration forms for preschool and kindergarten students for the 2022-23 school year. Registration packets will be available on **March 31** in the elementary office, or you may call Secretary Marilyn Kamphaus and request that one be mailed to you. Students are not considered registered unless the school has received a completed packet. Registration help is available in English and Spanish in the office.

## **PRESCHOOL INFORMATION:**

Entiat will offer one or more sessions of half-day preschool Monday through Friday, depending on how many students enroll. It is important that you register early so that your preference for morning or afternoon can be considered as students are assigned to a session. Preference will be given to students who reside in the Entiat School District, and non-residents will be enrolled as space permits. To enter **Preschool**, children must be **4 years of age** on or before August 31, 2022.

## **KINDERGARTEN INFORMATION:**

Only children who were not enrolled in our district preschool at the end of the 2021-22 school year must register for kindergarten for 2022-23. Children must be **5 years of age** on or before August 31, 2022 to enter **kindergarten**.

### **When you submit your registration packet, you will also need to bring:**

- ◆ Your child's **birth certificate**
- ◆ Your child's **immunization record** – law requires that the immunization record be **medically verified**. This means immunization records must be from a health care provider or verified by a health care provider. Here are examples of acceptable records:
  - \* A completed Certificate of Immunization Status (CIS) signed by a health care provider
  - \* A CIS filled out by the parent/guardian with medical records attached
  - \* A CIS printed by a health care provider or school from the online Washington State Immunization Information System
  - \* A CIS printed from MyIR, a free Dept. of Health online tool that allows families to view and print their official record themselves
  - \* If the parent/guardian is requesting an exemption from one or more of the immunization requirements (MMR is not eligible for exemption), the parent/guardian must provide the school a completed Certificate of Exemption

If your current living situation is such that you cannot provide all documents needed, please contact the Counselor, Susan Morris at 784-1314.

## **IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS:**

If your child's immunizations are not current at registration time, and you have immunizations scheduled for prior to the start of school, proof of a doctor's appointment date will be acceptable for registration. Immunizations must be current before the start of school and the medically verified record must be submitted **before a student can attend school** – this is a requirement of the new law.

Washington law requires children entering **Preschool or Kindergarten** to have the following immunizations:

# ¡¡REGISTRO DE PREESCOLAR Y KÍNDER!!

A partir del **lunes 11 de abril**, la oficina de la escuela primaria comenzará a aceptar paquetes de registro para estudiantes de preescolar y kínder para el año escolar 2022-23. Empezando el **31 de marzo**, paquetes de registro estarán disponibles en la oficina de la escuela primaria, o puede llamar y pedir que se los manden por correo. Los estudiantes no se consideran registrados hasta que la escuela haya recibido un paquete **completo**. La ayuda de registro está disponible en inglés y español en la oficina.

## **INFORMACIÓN DE PREESCOLAR:**

Entiat ofrecerá una o más sesiones de medio día de preescolar de lunes a viernes, dependiendo de cuántos estudiantes se inscriban. Es importante que se registre temprano para que su preferencia de por la mañana o la tarde pueda ser considerada cuando asignamos a estudiantes a una sesión. Se dará preferencia a los estudiantes que residen en el Distrito Escolar de Entiat, y los que no residen en Entiat se inscribirá cuando el espacio lo permita. Para entrar **Preescolar**, los niños deben tener **4 años** en o antes del 31 de agosto de 2022.

## **INFORMACIÓN DE KÍNDER:**

Sólo los niños que no estaban registrados en nuestro preescolar del distrito al final del año escolar 2021-22 deben registrarse para kínder para el año escolar 2022-23. Los niños deben tener **5 años** en o antes del 31 de agosto de 2022 para entrar al **kínder**.

### **Cuando entregar su paquete de registro, también tendrá que traer:**

- ♦ el **certificado de nacimiento** de su hijo/a
- ♦ el **registro de vacunas** de su hijo/a– requiere que el registro de vacunas sea **verificado medicamente**. Esto significa que los registros de vacunas deben ser de un proveedor de servicios médicos o verificados por un proveedor de servicios médicos. Aquí están los ejemplos de registros aceptables:
  - \* Un Certificado de Estado de Vacunas (CEV) (CIS, por sus siglas en inglés) completo y firmado por un proveedor médico.
  - \* Un CEV (CIS) completado por usted u otro padre o tutor legal con registros médicos adjuntos
  - \* Un CEV (CIS) impreso por un proveedor médico o una escuela usando el Sistema Informático de Vacunas del estado de Washington.
  - \* Un CEV (CIS) impreso desde el portal MyIR (en inglés), un instrumento gratis en línea del Departamento de Salud que permite a las familias ver e imprimir sus registros oficiales de vacunas.
  - \* Si solicita una exención de uno o más de los requisitos de vacunación, debe proporcionarle a la escuela un Certificado de exención completo.

Si su situación es tal que usted no puede proporcionar todos los documentos necesarios, por favor comuníquese con Susan Morris al 784-1314.

## **REQUISITOS DE VACUNAS:**

Si las vacunas de su hijo/a no están actualizadas en el momento de registro, y tiene las vacunas previstas antes del inicio de la escuela, prueba de la fecha de la cita de un doctor será aceptable para el registro. Las vacunas deben ser actualizadas antes del primer día de clases y el registro de vacunas verificado medicamente, presentado **antes de que el estudiante pueda asistir a clases** – esto es un requisito de la nueva ley.

La ley de Washington requiere que los niños que entran **Preescolar o Kínder** tengan las vacunas siguientes:

# Highly Capable Program Nominations

Dear Families and Community Members,

We are accepting nominations for Highly Capable program screening for our Entiat students for the 2022-23 school year. Please note, ALL 2nd graders and students new to Entiat will be screened using the Cognitive Abilities Test (CogAT). Please see below for Washington State's definition of Highly Capable. (WAC [392-170-035](#), WAC [392-170-036](#)) Students may be nominated any time during the school year by parents, community members or teachers.

## *Definition of Highly Capable:*

*"Students who perform or show potential for performing at significantly advanced academic levels when compared with others of their age, experiences, or environments. Outstanding abilities are seen within students' general intellectual aptitudes, specific academic abilities, and/or creative productivities within a specific domain. Students who are highly capable may possess, but are not limited to, these learning characteristics:*

- (1) Capacity to learn with unusual depth of understanding, to retain what has been learned, and to transfer learning to new situations;*
- (2) Capacity and willingness to deal with increasing levels of abstraction and complexity earlier than their chronological peers;*
- (3) Creative ability to make unusual connections among ideas and concepts;*
- (4) Ability to learn quickly in their area(s) of intellectual strength; and*
- (5) Capacity for intense concentration and/or focus."*

- (4) Capacidad de aprender rápidamente en sus áreas de fortaleza intelectual;
