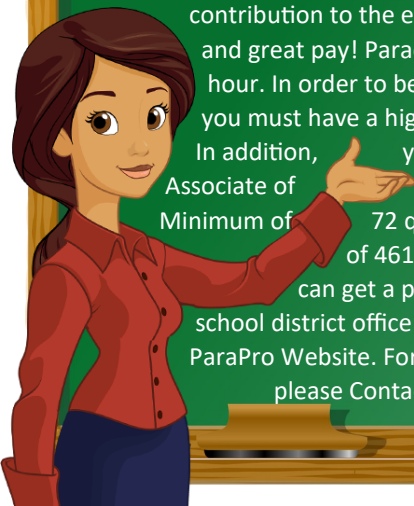
I hope you all are as blessed as I am and getting some time with family and again, I thank you for trusting your child to Entiat Schools and thank you for being part of the "Tiger Team."

SUBSTITUTE PARAEDUCATORS NEEDED!

Working as a substitute Paraeducator is a great way to make a positive contribution to the education of Entiat kids. Flexible hours and great pay! Paraeducators are paid \$17.91- \$21.64 per hour. In order to be qualified as a substitute paraeducator, you must have a high school diploma or G.E.D. credential. In addition, you must have one of the following:

- Associate of Arts (A.A.) Degree or higher -OR
- Minimum of 72 quarter college credits -OR Passing score of 461 on the ETS ParaPro Assessment . You can get a practice test to study by contacting the school district office at 784-1800 or purchase online at ETS ParaPro Website. 



Our Leadership class participates in the WSDOT's Adopt-A-Highway program on 97A, and our fall crew did a great job!
