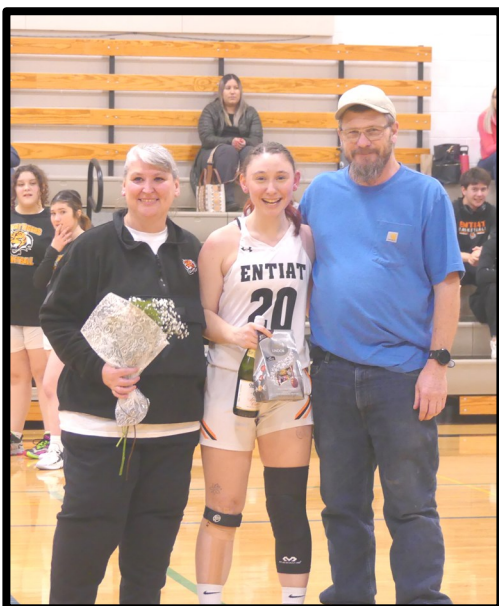

Dear Entiat Families and Community Members,

Congratulations! We are already to February. This means we made it through the long month of January. A lot went on at our school in the first month of 2024 including the snowstorms, a late start, bus delays due to weather, hiring of new staff members. Most of my work centered on the important date we have coming this month. February 13, 2024. This is the deadline to get your voting ballot turned in. If you are a registered voter in the Entiat School District, most of you, if not all of you, will see just one item on your vote-by-mail ballot. The one proposition listed will be the Entiat School District 4-year Replacement EP&O Levy. The Educational Programs and Operations Levy (formerly called Maintenance & Operations) pays for programs/services in our school that the State does not fund. It replaces a 4-year levy that voters (many of you) approved 4 years ago in 2020. I have made several presentations through the month of January sharing information about this levy. As I have stated over and over, I firmly believe the school is the heart and soul of our community. 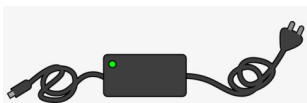
