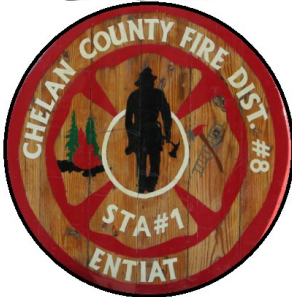

SCHOOL BOARD MESSAGE

Dear Entiat Parents, Guardians, and Community,

Every few years as you're filling out your ballot in the general election, you've probably noticed one or more candidates for school board director. In Entiat, there is rarely more than one candidate per position, so you vote for that individual, drop your ballot in the box, and don't think about it again until the next election cycle.

But have you ever stopped to wonder about what the school board does-- and does not-- do? According to the Washington State School Directors Association, or WSSDA, school board directors have six main functions:

- Set the vision, mission, and strategic goals for the district
- Review, revise and adopt policies
- Establish and oversee the budget
- Monitor the district's progress towards its goals
- Hire, supervise and evaluate the superintendent
- Serve as community representatives

All of these roles are important to ensuring our students get the best education available to them, but the one I want to focus on today is that we, the members of the Entiat School Board, serve as your representatives when it comes to making decisions about what is best for our students and our community. In order to serve as your representatives, we need to know what you are thinking! There are many ways you can reach out to school board members with questions or concerns. Members of the public are always welcome to our regularly scheduled board meetings on the third Thursday of each month. The agenda is posted online and at the post office a few days in advance. With current COVID restrictions, our board meetings have been online, so you can participate via Zoom from the comfort of your home.

In the past, many community concerns have been brought to the board through casual conversations at school events, church, or even random encounters while getting gas or running errands. The school website also has contact information for individual board members. We recently established a new email account dedicated to school board business, so you can now send messages to the board at entiatsschoolboard@gmail.com.

Whichever way you choose to contact us, we welcome the opportunity to hear from you. It's an honor for us to serve our children and community as school board directors, and we take the responsibility seriously.

PRESCHOOL & KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION!!

PRESCHOOL INFORMATION:

Entiat will offer one or more sessions of half-day preschool Monday through Friday, depending on how many students enroll. It is important that you register early so that your preference for morning or afternoon can be considered as students are assigned to a session. Preference will be given to students who reside in the Entiat School District, and non-residents will be enrolled as space permits. To enter **Preschool**, children must be **4 years of age** on or before August 31, 2021. Registration packets are available in the office.

KINDERGARTEN INFORMATION:

Only children who were not enrolled in our district preschool at the end of the 2020-21 school year must register for kindergarten for 2021-22. Children must be **5 years of age** on or before August 31, 2020 to enter **kindergarten**.

When you submit your registration packet, you will also need to bring:

- ◆ Your child's **birth certificate**
- ◆ Your child's **immunization record** – a new law going into effect for the 2020-21 school year requires that the immunization record be **medically verified**. This means immunization records must be from a health care provider or verified by a health care provider. Here are examples of acceptable records:
 - A completed Certificate of Immunization Status (CIS) signed by a health care provider
 - A CIS filled out by the parent/guardian with medical records attached
 - A CIS printed by a health care provider or school from the online Washington State Immunization Information System
 - A CIS printed from MyIR, a free Dept. of Health online tool that allows families to view and print their official record themselves
 - If the parent/guardian is requesting an exemption from one or more of the immunization requirements (MMR is not eligible for exemption), the parent/guardian must provide the school a completed Certificate of Exemption

If your current living situation is such that you cannot provide all documents needed, please contact the Dean of Students Miles Caples at 784-1800.

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS:

If your child's immunizations are not current at registration time, and you have immunizations scheduled for prior to the start of school, proof of a doctor's appointment date will be acceptable for registration. Immunizations must be current before the start of school and the medically verified record must be submitted **before a student can attend school** – this is a requirement of the new law.

Washington law requires children entering **Preschool or Kindergarten** to have the following immunizations:

<i>Vaccine</i>	<i>Requirement</i>
PRESCHOOL ONLY (Not needed for Kindergarten):	
Hib (Haemophilus influenzae type B)	3 or 4 doses (depending on vaccine used)
PCV (Pneumococcal Conjugate)	Up to 4 doses, depending on when given before age 5
PRESCHOOL & KINDERGARTEN:	
Hepatitis B	3 doses
DTaP (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis)	5 doses (4 doses only IF dose #4 given on or after 4 th birthday and at least 6 months after dose #3)
Varicella (Chickenpox)	2 doses OR Health Care Provider verification of disease
Polio (IPV)	4 doses (3 doses only IF dose #3 given on or after 4 th birthday and at least 6 months after dose #2)
Measles, Mumps & Rubella (MMR)	2 doses

¡¡REGISTRO DE PREESCOLAR Y KÍNDER!!

INFORMACIÓN DE PREESCOLAR:

Entiat ofrecerá una o más sesiones de medio día de preescolar de lunes a viernes, dependiendo de cuántos estudiantes se inscriban. Es importante que se registre temprano para que su preferencia de por la mañana o la tarde pueda ser considerada cuando asignamos a estudiantes a una sesión. Se dará preferencia a los estudiantes que residen en el Distrito Escolar de Entiat, y los que no residen en Entiat se inscribirá cuando el espacio lo permita. Para entrar **Preescolar**, los niños deben tener **4 años** en o antes del 31 de agosto de 2020. Paquetes de registro están disponibles en la oficina.

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INFORMACIÓN DE KÍNDER:

Sólo los niños que no estaban registrados en nuestro preescolar del distrito al final del año escolar 2019-20 deben registrarse para kínder para el año escolar 2020-21. Los niños deben tener **5 años** en o antes del 31 de agosto de 2020 para entrar al **kínder**.

Cuando entregar su paquete de registro, también tendrá que traer:

el **certificado de nacimiento** de su hijo/a

el **registro de vacunas** de su hijo/a– una nueva ley que entra en efecto para el año escolar 2020-21 requiere que el registro de vacunas sea **verificado medicamente**. Esto significa que los registros de vacunas deben ser de un proveedor de servicios médicos o verificados por un proveedor de servicios médicos. Aquí están los ejemplos de registros aceptables:

- Un Certificado de Estado de Vacunas (CEV) (CIS, por sus siglas en inglés) completo y firmado por un proveedor médico.
- Un CEV (CIS) completado por usted u otro padre o tutor legal con registros médicos adjuntos
- Un CEV (CIS) impreso por un proveedor médico o una escuela usando el Sistema Informático de Vacunas del estado de Washington.
- Un CEV (CIS) impreso desde el portal MyIR (en inglés), un instrumento gratis en línea del Departamento de Salud que permite a las familias ver e imprimir sus registros oficiales de vacunas.
- Si solicita una exención de uno o más de los requisitos de vacunación, debe proporcionarle a la escuela un Certificado de exención completo.

Si su situación es tal que usted no puede proporcionar todos los documentos necesarios, por favor comuníquese con Miles Caple al 784-1800.

REQUISITOS DE VACUNAS:

Si las vacunas de su hijo/a no están actualizadas en el momento de registro, y tiene las vacunas previstas antes del inicio de la escuela, prueba de la fecha de la cita de un doctor será aceptable para el registro. Las vacunas deben ser actualizadas antes del primer día de clases y el registro de vacunas verificado medicamente, presentado **antes de que el estudiante pueda asistir a clases** – esto es un requisito de la nueva ley.

La ley de Washington requiere que los niños que entran **Preescolar o Kinder** tengan las vacunas siguientes:

Vacuna	Requisito
SOLAMENTE PREESCOLAR (No es necesario para Kinder):	
Hib (Haemophilus influenzae tipo B)	3 o 4 dosis (dependiendo de la vacuna usada)
PCV (neumococica conjugada)	hasta 4 dosis, dependiendo de cuándo se administra antes de edad 5
PREESCHOOL & KINDERGARTEN:	
Hepatitis B	3 dosis
DTaP (difteria, tétanos, tos ferina)	5 dosis (4 dosis solo si la dosis #4 se administra en o después de 4 años y al menos 6 meses después de la dosis #3)
Varicela (viruela loca)	2 dosis o verificación de la enfermedad por parte del proveedor médico
Polio (IPV)	4 dosis (3 dosis solo si la dosis #4 se administra en o después de 4 años y al menos 6 meses después de la dosis #2)
Sarampión, paperas y rubeola (MMR)	2 dosis

All pre-K through 5th grade students need a backpack large enough to carry folders and paperwork. No wheels please.

All supplies other than folders are shared by the class. Please do not label with individual names.

DO NOT SEND pencil toppers shaped erasers, stencils, glitter glue, or other similar items.

NOTE for parents of elementary students! The school district has coordinated with the classroom teachers in grades preK-5 to reduce the amount of school supplies that parents are asked to provide in the fall. Instead, the district will purchase these supplies in bulk and help you keep a few more dollars in your pocket!

4th & 5th Grade Band: 1" binder (any color), 10 clear sleeves, pencil pouch to fit inside binder, 2 pencil, 1 high lighter. (needs/oil/grease as needed for instrument) Dress for Performances: Girl black skirt/pants and white top. Boys: Black slacks, white button-up shirt & tie.

P.E.: K-5: water bottle & tennis shoes that tie.

P.E.: 6th-12th grade: Black gym shorts or sweats, grey or orange shirt, socks and tennis shoes.

6th, 7th, & 8th: Pencils, pens (black or blue), erasers, 3-ring binder, notebooks paper, highlighter, dividers, pencil pouch, colored pencils, glue stick, 6 spiral notebooks, Scientific calculator (TI-34 Multi-View (recommended) or graphing calculator (TI-84 will be used in high school)).

Art: Smock (old shirt is fine).

Band: Pencil pouch to fit inside binder, 2 pencil, 1 highlighter. (needs/oil/grease as needed for instrument). Dress for Performance: Girls: black skirt/pants and white top. Boys: Black slacks, white button-up shirt & tie. 3" inch binder, solid black marching shoes.

High School: Pencils, pens (blue or black), erasers, 3-ring binder, notebook paper, dividers, colored pencils, scissors, glue stick.

Band: Pencil pouch to fit inside binder, 2 pencil, 1 highlighter. (needs/oil/grease as needed for instrument). Dress for Performance: Girls: black skirt/pants and white top. Boys: Black slacks, white button-up shirt & tie. 3" inch binder, solid black marching shoes.

Art: Smock (old shirt is fine).

History: 1.5" or 2" binder to be left in the classroom.

Math: graphing calculator (TI 83 or TI 84), 2.5" to 3" binder, 500 sheets of 3-hole punched graph paper (4 squares per inch), 2 red pens. Compass, protractor, subject dividers, 4 colored pencils (optional).

Science: Spiral bound notebook or composition notebook, 1.5" 3-ring binder, ruler.

Spanish: 5 packages of lined paper, small box of #2 pencils, Crayola markers, a highlighter and red pen.
