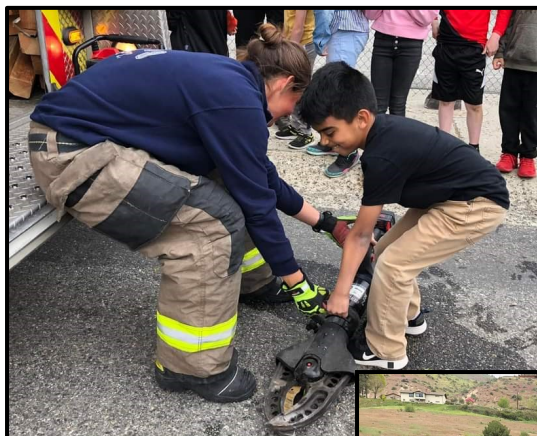
Kaia Tucker, Necia Sax, Karsun Cole and Trent Renslow were selected to the All-League Honorable Mention Teams.
