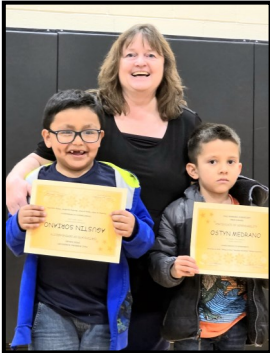

Queridas familias y miembros de la comunidad de Entiat:

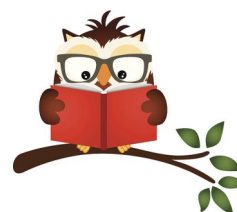

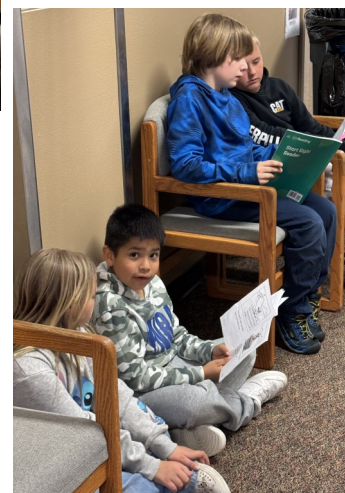

- * FAFSA continues to be open, we recommend that all 12th grade students complete the FAFSA to keep their options open for any University/Trade School/ Community College.
- * Weekly scholarships are sent out to all 12th graders at the beginning of each week.
