



## Tiger Fitness Test

Each Fall Entiat Elementary students participate in the Tiger Fitness Test. The test measures each individual's fitness level and involves the following 5 components. Sit and Reach to measure flexibility, Pull-ups and/or Flexed Arm Hang to determine muscle strength, Curl-ups define muscle strength and endurance, Shuttle Run to measure explosive speed and the ¼ or ½ Mile Run to calculate Cardiovascular Endurance.

Upon completion of the test, each student's results are compared to nation wide standards. Individuals who reach specific levels receive the Tiger Fitness Award.

## **School Board Update:**

Our school district, like many public agencies, has an elected board of directors with the responsibility to carry out certain laws, to establish and appraise educational activities of the district, and to be responsible to the desires of the majority of the citizens of the district. School boards set budgets, establish policies, and guide the district with the fundamental priority of assuring student learning occurs in our schools.

In many ways, a worthy board of directors is much like a good officiating team at a sporting event—most effective when no one notices their role in the game. Like sports officials, school boards make many calls, and from time to time they are called upon to make difficult or even controversial decisions. All of this work, much of which takes place away from the monthly board meeting, is done for free.

We have had some recent changes in the makeup of your Entiat school board, so this an excellent time to reintroduce the community to our board members. First, we would like to extend special thanks to two individuals who recently left the board. After taking a break from previous board service, Victor Porrovecchio was re-appointed seven years ago to fill an unexpired term. Mr. Porrovecchio has moved out of Entiat and therefore is unable to continue his service to the board. Although he will no longer be on the board, he continues to be a great supporter of our school and community. Also departing our board is Brenda Lamb. After 10 years of serving on the board, Brenda felt it was time to give others the opportunity to serve and contribute to our schools. ## **Emergency closure, late-start or early dismissal**

The following procedures will be employed by the district when, in the opinion of the administration, conditions exist which warrant school closure, delay or early dismissal.

**School Closure** will occur when conditions are so severe that it is not in the best interest of any students to be in school attendance. Parents will be notified by radio (560AM, 102.1FM KPQ and 93.5FM KOZI), and informational messages will be available at 784-0402 and 784-1800. Information will also be posted at [www.entiatsschools.org](http://www.entiatsschools.org) by 7:00am when possible.


**Delayed Opening** situations may occur which will delay school opening one hour and 45 minutes (start time of 10:00) If your students' bus does not arrive within fifteen minutes of its regular time, please tune to KPQ or KOZI for information concerning the delayed opening.

Students who arrive at school because they did not hear the closure or delay information are asked to go to the high school office.

**Early Dismissal** situations may occur in which school would be released at an earlier time. Before releasing students, we would attempt to contact parents, and notify radio stations (KPQ and KOZI). Normal bus take home routes would be in effect. If the driver determines there to be no adult supervision, the student will be returned to school and kept safe under adult supervision, until the guardian arrives.

# Math is Cool

Entiat's 12<sup>th</sup> grade Math is Cool team culminated their ninth consecutive year at the Math Is Cool State Championships on December 05, 2015 in Moses Lake. The team concluded their highly successful *Math Is Cool* careers by claiming the 5<sup>th</sup> place trophy in the 12<sup>th</sup> grade competition. The team consists of Benjamin Southard, Ulises Pina, Trang Tran and Edwin Medina.

Teams have to finish in the top 4 spots in regional competitions in order to qualify for the *Math IS Cool State Championships*. Our team has finished in the top 4 every year except for one. As 5<sup>th</sup> graders they finished in 5<sup>th</sup> place (only 2 points out of 4<sup>th</sup>) and were the alternate team for the *State Championships*. Benjamin Southard qualified as an individual that year by placing 2<sup>nd</sup> in the regional competition. Each year the top 8 individuals from regionals qualify for the State Competition, even if their team does not qualify.

Over the nine years of competing the team's make-up has not changed much. Benjamin Southard and Edwin Medina were the only two from the original 4<sup>th</sup> grade team that competed all 9 years. Ulises Pina joined the team in the 5<sup>th</sup> grade (8 years), and Trang Tran joined in the 6<sup>th</sup> grade (7 years). Other early team members included Austin Kiser (4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> grade) and Cierra Kohlman (4<sup>th</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> grade). Benjamin Southard is the only team member to qualify for the State Championships all 9 years. In addition to qualifying as a team member 8 out of 9 years, he qualified as an individual 6 times.
